

## **Prospect High School PTSA Minutes for November 09, 2010**

**Call to order:** Meeting was called to order at 7:0 p.m.

Welcome and Introductions: Liz began with welcoming everyone and introductions of all PTSA members, students and parents along with Principal Diane Burbank.

### **Secretary's minutes:**
