College and Career Center Update

Thank you, all, for your UC/CSU college enthusiasm at the end of November! Our seniors worked diligently to make the Thursday deadline.

The CCC study hall saw over 40 seniors that week alone for application help which made the December 1st celebration all the sweeter! All UC and most CSU applications are complete. Thank you for the support of our first annual High Fives & Hot Chocolates. We served over 160 hot chocolates to seniors and hundreds more high

fives!

Currently, we have 165 seniors with over 1700 active applications listed on Naviance to approximately 250 schools. We have 38 known acceptances to 24 schools - Humboldt State University, Western Oregon University, Evergreen State College, Portland State University, Arizona State University, Pacific University, University of Minnesota Twin City, Cal Poly SLO, Columbia College, Concordia University, CSU Stanislaus, Oregon Inst of Tech, Oregon State University, SJSU, University of Montana, University of Nevada Reno, University of Oregon, University of the Pacific, Dominican University, U of CO Colorado Springs, Univ of Portland, St Mary's College of CA, Whittier College and Washington State Univ.

Seniors are starting to report scholarship offers!!
The Class of 2018's scholarship offer total is at \$436,000 so far.

Westmont hosted a District-wide College Fair November 30th for out of state colleges. There were over 300 students and parents in attendance with 25 schools representative available to meet with families and answer questions. The energy at the event was extremely positive and everyone is looking forward to Prospect's College Fair in February.

Our Career Exploration Seminar on Tuesday, December 5th, was a huge success.

Representatives from Mission and De Anza Colleges were here to discuss options for students considering a more direct pathway to the workforce. 90 seniors were invited to attend and 28 came to the seminar. Although the presentation ended at the beginning of lunch,

almost every attendee lingered to ask questions.
Every student left with a great sense of purpose.

Our December 14th College & Career Workshop will review proper etiquette for interviews and other social situations. Then, our Career Spotlights on December 13th will feature an architecture. All events will be held in the library during study hall on their respective days.

Scholarships and Job Postings now have a place in the library. Please share any additional opportunities you hear about with the College & career Center. Job postings are also list on our webpage and scholarships on Naviance. Thank you to all who helped with Open House! It was a big success and next year we will need even more volunteers. We had over 140 families wanting to learn more about Prospect and our ASB Students, Principals, Staff and parents worked tirelessly giving tours and answering questions. Great job Prospect!
